Set-up will be from 10 am -3 pm on Friday, and tear down will be from 5-7 pm Sat.

This is a sale of tiles, mosaics, and tile and mosaic related objects. No pots or vessels will be allowed (unless they are tiled). Tiles must be handmade or have historic value to participate. Vendors may be asked to remove items that do not meet these criteria from their tables.

ATNW will provide 30” x 72” tables and black tablecloths.

Vendors are responsible for collecting State of Washington/City of Seattle sales tax, and you must have UBI # to participate in the **Tile Festival**.

No refund of table reservation after September 15.

The Artist/Exhibitor agrees to release Pioneer Hall, Artisan Tile NW, their agents, employees, and volunteers from any and all liability stemming from participation in the NW Tile Festival, including any claims for damage of loss to their persons or property.
